

# **MARGUERITE McCRIMMON**

## **1903 - 1989**

Marguerite McCrimmon, age 85 of Royal Oak, formerly of Lake Township near Pinnebog, passed away Wednesday, Jan. 25 in William Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak, after a short illness.

She was born July 13, 1903 in Lake Township, daughter of the late James and Margaret (Arthur) McCrimmon.

Miss McCrimmon attended Rock City Rural School and Pinnebog School and graduated from Bad Axe High School in 1921. She graduated from Eastern Michigan State College and earned a master's degree in education from the University of Michigan.

She was principal at the Angell Elementary School, Berkley and retired in 1962. She was a member of First United Methodist Church, Royal Oak and was a member of Alpha Delta Kappa sorority, Berkley.
