Mrs. Lydia M. Teuscher, 84 of Goshen, IN. and formerly of Pigeon, passed away Thursday, Sept. 19 at Greencroft Healthcare, after having suffered from declining health for the past several years.

She was born May 17, 1912 to Joseph and Anna (Hochstetler) Shetler in Pigeon, where she lived until 1992. She was united in marriage to Harry W. Teuscher on March 18, 1934. He preceded her in death on March 29, 1972.
