The Management of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show reserves the right to construe, amend, add to, and interpret the rules and regulations, and to arbitrarily settle and to determine all matters and differences in regard thereto including amendments, or otherwise arising out of, connected with, or any incident pertaining to the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show. Complaints are to be made, in writing, within 30 days of the last day of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show to the General Manager, Volusia County Fair Association, Inc.
- 2. Exhibitors must live in Volusia County. Youth must meet age requirements as of September 1st, of the current year, and be enrolled and in attendance in an elementary school, high school, or home school in Volusia County at the time of entering items in the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show,
- 3. <u>Social Security or Federal ID Number:</u> If a Social Security Number or Federal ID Number is not provided, the Volusia County Fair reserves the right to not issue premium Money or sale checks. Any exhibitor with a premium amount of \$100 or more will be required to provide a Social Security Number or Tax ID Number.
- 4. Premium Book and official entry forms are available online at: www.volusiacountyfair.com. A copy of the Premium Book may be obtained at the Fair Office (No mail, fax or email).
- 5. All exhibits entered for competition shall be subject to the control of the Superintendent of the department, with the approval of Fair management, in which they are exhibited. Exhibitors are not permitted to remove, handle, rearrange, improve or disfigure the same under any circumstances. No exhibit shall be removed in whole or part during the period of the Fair except by permission of the Fair Management.
- 6. Removal of Exhibits: Entry exhibits not picked up on the Removal Day will become the property of the Fair Association. The Fair cannot store any exhibits and therefore, the Fair Association assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to exhibits not removed on the Removal Day.
- 7. The Fair Management reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed unsuitable as a Volusia County Fair & Youth Show exhibit.
- 8. Decision of judges is final. Exhibitors, parents and general public are not allowed, in the building(s) during the judging. of exhibits.
- 9. Judging Method AMERICAN SYSTEM
 - Exhibits in this system are compared against a standard of perfection, as well as against the other entries in the competition. All exhibits in a particular class are looked at and ranked with only one selected for first place, second place, third place, etc. If there are no high quality exhibits, at the judge's discretion, exhibits may be placed in the appropriate position, even if it is second or third place.
- 10. For rules and regulations governing each department, see rules in that department.
- 11. Responsibility: Upon signing the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show entry form, the exhibitor, parent and/or guardian agree that the Volusia County Fair Association, Inc. and the County of Volusia and/or it representatives are not to be held responsible for any exhibit entered for exhibition or for personal injury due to accidents, fire, theft or providential destruction. The Fair Association will exercise responsible vigilance in the care of exhibits for exhibition but exhibits are entered at owner's risk. Any exhibits entered into the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show may be photographed and used by Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., for advertising. The Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to exhibits from any cause and upon this condition only are exhibits accepted.
- 12. Premium Award Monies and Checks:
 - 1. Premiums will be paid on the basis of the judging and cash award reports, which must be verified and signed by the department superintendent.
 - 2. Premium Monies and Checks are given on the Removal Day when exhibits are picked up.
 - 3. Premium checks awarded by the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show shall be cashed by the exhibitor within 90 days from the date of the check.
 - 4. Premium Monies awarded to an exhibitor, will be held at the Fair Office for 60 days after the last day of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show.
 - 5. If the exhibitor fails to timely negotiate a check or collect money, after 90 days, all money due exhibitor shall belong to the Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., and the exhibitor shall be deemed to have made an unconditional and irrevocable gift of said monies to the Volusia County Fair Association.
 - 6. Premium Money and/or checks are not mailed.

1939 WORLD'S FAIR DIORAMA'S

The Diorama's from the 1939 World's Fair in New York were donated to the Volusia County Fair in 1982 by James Burkhalter. In 2007, the dioramas were redone to their original state by Mr. Burkhalter. The dioramas are on permanent display in "Mitchell's Old Plantation" by the Model Train Display.

"MITCHELL'S OLD PLANTATION BUILDING"

When you enter the "Mitchell's Old Plantation", you step back to the days that may be recalled as "The Good Old Days". As you walk the through "Mitchell's Old Plantation", it seems that you are in the days of an era long ago.

As you walk through the Old Planation Building, you will see the preservation of energy - including a fire-less cooker, a dog treadmill and many other interesting exhibits. There are horse drawn surreys, buggies, wagons, and a chuck wagon, hand tools crudely made of wood and stone, and handmade wood carvings and machines that were used for everyday basic needs.

Engineering & Technology Education - Department 1000

The Volusia County Fair Technology Education Program is an activity designed to encourage the understanding of technology and development of craftsmanship among secondary students enrolled in engineering and technology education. The program offers awards for excellence demonstrated at the county level competition at the Volusia County Fairgrounds, DeLand, Florida.

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY:

Any entry made in school under the supervision of a technology education teacher and which qualifies according to the rules and regulations may be entered. At least 70% of the project must be fabricated in the school laboratory.

Entries in Divisions 1001, 1002, 1003 and 1004 must be individual entries. Team/Class projects may be presented for display only. Division 1005 may be individual entries or team projects.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES:

All Divisions may be entered but only one (1) entry per Class. For example: you may enter one (1) entry of a residence drafting project and one (1) entry of an object drafting project and one (1) entry of an engineering project and one (1) entry of a metal table top object — these are all in different classes. You may NOT enter a drafting of an airplane engine and a drafting of another type of engine — these are in the same class. Entries in Divisions 1001, 1002, 1003 and 1004 must be individuals. Team/Class projects in Divisions 1001, 1002, 1003 and 1004 may be presented for display only.

JUDGING:

- 1. The Danish System of judging will be used where there can be numerous Blue Ribbon awards with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd awarded in Divisions 1001, 1002, and 1003.
- 2. Projects completed in the past school year are eligible for this year. Projects exhibited in the Fair last year are not eligible.
- 3. All 1st place winners in Divisions 1001, 1002 and 1003 only are judged against each other for the Best of Show Awards.

Division 1001 - Class: A - High School

All projects in Division 1001 must be mounted on poster board or better (4 ply minimum). All dimensions must be included with each project entered.

Class:

A. Drafting Architectural - Project will consist of a rendering of a residence. The rendering can be of the inside or out. The coloring and/or shading can be produced manually or by using CAD. All drawings should be submitted on either B or C size paper.

B. Drafting Engineering - Project will consist of an object that was created using 3D solids modeling. Drawing should be printed in either a realistic look with color or as a 3D hidden look. The drawing should include either an exploded view or sectional views to show the interior pieces and does not require dimensions. All drawings should be submitted on either C or D size paper.

- CAD D-ARCHITECTURAL Any student created drawing meeting general architectural standards.
- CAD D-ENGINEERING Any student created drawing which should include dimensions.
- * Blueprint may be used if certified by instructor. No tracings accepted.

All projects in Division 1002 should be small in nature, (i.e., objects that sit on a table, counter, shelf, hangs on the wall). Class:
