## Workshop/Breakout Room

Instructions:

Please let all workshop participants know they must sign-in online in order to be assigned to a breakout room/workshop.

If they dial-in for Church School, the tech team will not be able to identify them and they will automatically be placed in the "Adult" workshop.

In addition, any participant that plans on joining the Primary (ages 3-9), Senior (ages 10-17), or Young Adult/YA (ages 18-45) workshops must rename themselves "First Name, Primary/Senior/YA" (ex: rename "Galaxy 4567" to "Brenda, YA"). This will notify the host which room to assign you to. If you are a parent with multiple children of different age groups, you will have to use multiple devices for workshops or just select one.

The tech team will go over these instructions again before the Church School service and session begins.
