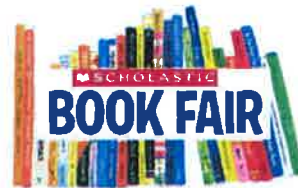


Open House: You are cordially invited to attend Open House on May 11 from 6:00-7:00. If you know of anyone who might be interested in enrolling their child, please invite them, too.
