Chairman Korth called the Town of Maple Creek Public Budget Hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. and led the pledge of allegiance.

Elected Officers present: Dalton Korth, Jim Young and Tory Much. Appointed Officer present: Lynette Gitter. There were no other residents present.

Elected Officer not present: Mike Bruette

The original notice for these minutes was posted at the three town posting boards Thursday, November 2, 2020. An amended agenda for the Town Board meeting was posted on November 13, 2020.

Those in attendance reviewed the 2021 proposed budget. A Town levy of \$67, 313 is proposed. This is the maximum levy set by the State without a resolution by the Electors. The Town Board decided not to do any road construction in 2021 so the extra funds were added to the Road Reserves for future use. \$5000 was added back into the Fire Equipment Fund and an additional \$5000 was added into the Town Revaluation Fund; that total is now \$25,000.

Young made a motion, seconded by Korth, to adjourn the Public Hearing at 6:32 p.m. ALL AYES. MOTION CARRIED.

**Discuss/Possible Action:**

**1) Correct Resolution #1-2020 for Refuse Disposal Charges to Resolution #2-2020**

**2) Budget Resolution #B1-2020**

A fire protection budget item transfer of \$6000 is needed to balance and finalize the 2019 Budget collected in 2020. This will be taken from the Fire Equipment Reserves. Young made a motion, seconded by Korth, to approve Resolution #B1-2020 which transfers \$6000 from the Fire Equipment Reserve Fund to the Fire Protection Account under Public Safety. ALL AYES. MOTION CARRIED.

**3) Finalize 2020 Budget**

No other transfers were necessary to finalize the 2020 budget. The clerk filed the final budget in the minutes.

**4) Make adjustments to 2021 Budget based on Public Hearing**

No adjustments were made as a result of the Public Hearing.

**5) Adopt the proposed 2021 budget.**

At the Special Meeting of the Electors, a municipal tax levy of \$67,313 for 2020 collected in 2021 was approved. The Town Board now needs to adopt the proposed budget. Young made a motion, seconded by Korth, to adopt the 2020 collected in 2021 proposed budget with a tax levy of \$67,313. ALL AYES. MOTION CARRIED.

Young made a motion, seconded by Korth, to adjourn the Special Town Board meeting at 6:45 p.m. ALL AYES. MOTION CARRIED.
