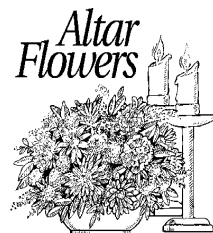

As the fanfares cease, may you sing of joy, even in the dark and lonely places.

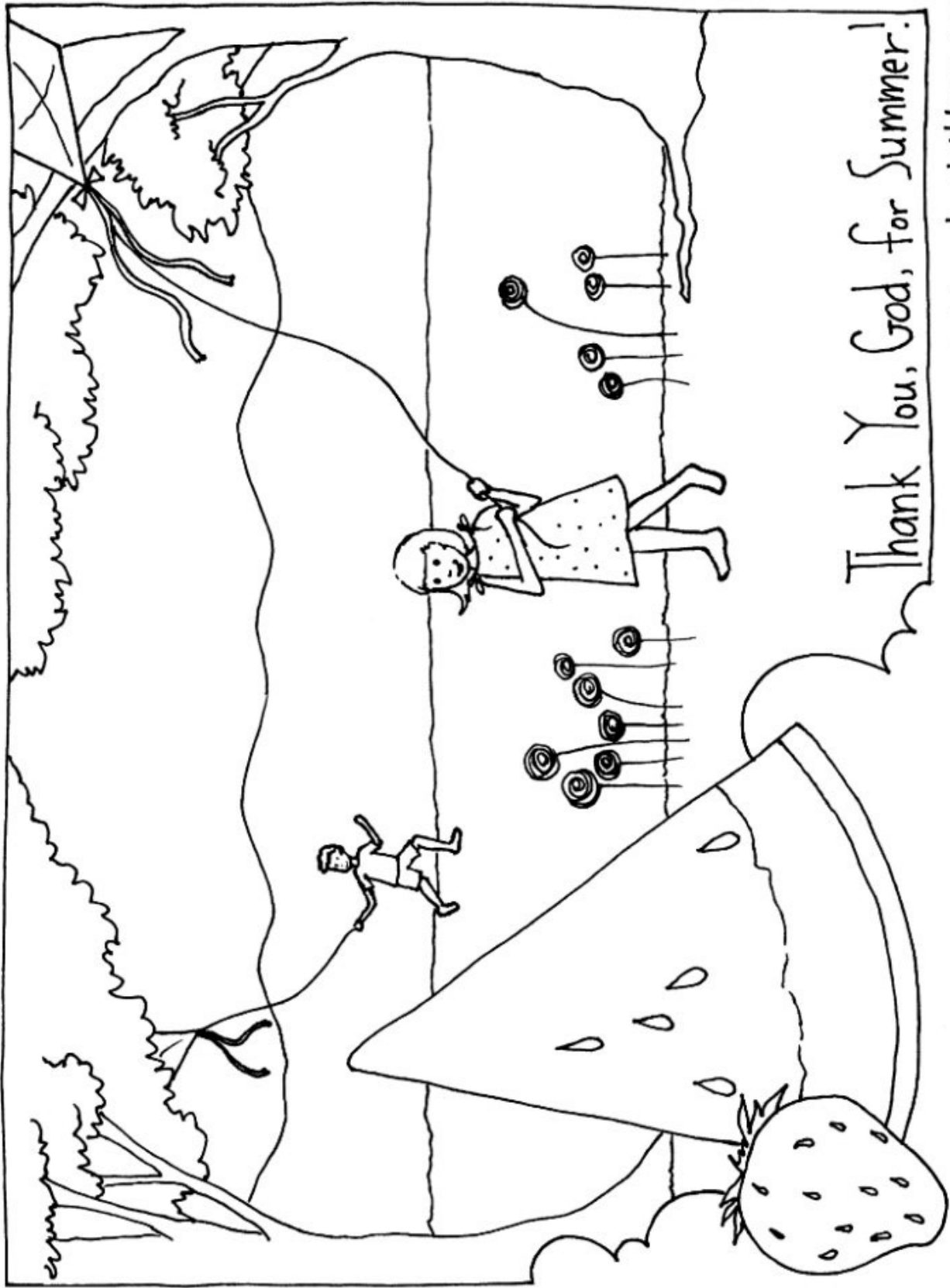
As the applause quiets, may you celebrate and lift up those around you.
