QUIZ: Fill in the blanks.

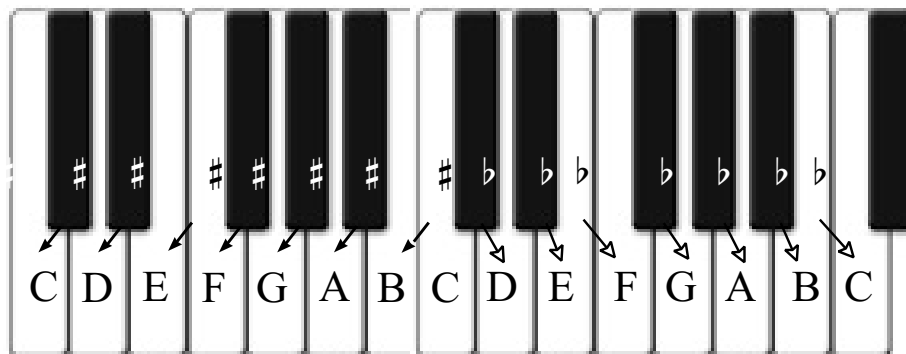
A  $\natural$  (natural) sign is written to \_\_\_\_\_ a note that has a sharp or flat.

For example, if there is a  $C\sharp$  in the bar and we want the next note to be a  $C$ , a natural sign is added to the  $C$  to cancel out the sharp.

a  $\natural$  note following a  $\sharp$  note: \_\_\_\_\_ the note by a half step ie.  $C\sharp$  to  $C\natural$

a  $\natural$  note following a  $\flat$  note: \_\_\_\_\_ the note by a half step ie.  $D\flat$  to  $D\natural$
