<u>**Trail Walk:**</u> Any Traditional Muzzleloader (separate Blanket Prize required for each one that you enter.). Trail Walks can be shot any time during the weekend. 3 separate classes, Flintlock, General and Trade Gun. (Medals awarded for Trade Gun, blanket prize not required.) You can shoot all three if you desire.

<u>Offhand Matches</u>: Assorted 25 to 50 yard off hand matches shot anytime during the weekend.

Team Fort Shoot: Get your team of 3 shooters together ,plan a strategy and knock down all of the targets in the shortest time frame, shot all day Saturday and Sunday morning.

<u>Pistol</u>: Gong Challenge (can be shot at anytime during the weekend). Paper target tie breaker at 25 yards. (Medals awarded.)

Shotgun: Sunday 9am, 10–16 birds depending upon the number of shooters participating.

Knife & Hawk: Various size targets .

Camping: Primitive and Modern available –outhouses on site—bring your own water. Pets must be on a leash, please follow the "pack it in pack it out rule" Period dress encouraged , but not mandatory.
