Camping Rules

- 1. All members are responsible for keeping a sanitary and attractive campground. Rubbish shall be placed in plastic bags and taken home or placed in the dumpster. A dumpster is located on the Southwest portion of the grounds next to the large pavilion. Please do not leave camping refuse in trash cans.
- 2. All sites shall be cleaned before leaving the area.
- 3. No sanitary wastes shall be disposed of on club grounds. No facilities are provided for such disposal.
- 4. For the sake of all members and campers Quiet hours shall be observed from 10pm to 6am. Disorderly conduct or unreasonable noise shall not be permitted.
- 5. All pets shall be kept leashed in the camping area.
- 6. Campfires shall be built in a safe place and completely put out before leaving.
- 7. No live trees or growth shall be cut for firewood or for any other reason without permission of the grounds committee.
- 8. Picnic tables shall not be moved around the club.
- 9. No camper or campsite shall block bank fishing access by other members.

10. No parking of any type of vehicle is permitted under or within twenty feet of the pavilion.

11. All camping is limited to a maximum of 6 days.

12. Electricity shall be unplugged when campers are left unoccupied for 24 hours or more.

13. Use of camper air conditioner: a fee of 3.00 dollars per day shall be collected and placed in a marked envelope. Deposit envelope in the guest fishing fee slot on the east side of the machine shed.

14. Access roads and boat ramps shall not be blocked by parked campers or vehicles at any time. Roads are to be kept clear for farming vehicles.

15. All campers are required to sign in at the main gate and indicate that they are camping.

16. No overnight guest camping without board approval. Guests are prohibited between midnight and 6:00AM.
