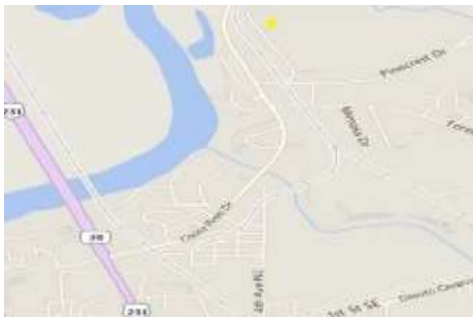


Directions to Red Eagle Skeet Club

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Annual Membership meeting will be held Saturday evening after the shoot-offs and dinner in the clubhouse. The 2019 All-State Team will be honored during the Saturday night state meeting following the shoot-offs and dinner.

The NSSA has once again contributed a free entry to the World Shoot to be awarded at our State Championship Shoot. The entry is to be awarded to an individual who has never previously attended the World Championship Shoot. There is no entry fee for this event. There will be a drawing Saturday night for one free entry to the 2019 World Shoot. Any shooter who has never participated in a World Championship Shoot is eligible.

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Please check your classes and entries carefully before leaving registration!

Any shooter who is misclassified or incorrectly entered/not entered in an event and not corrected prior to shooting will forfeit all Medals and Option Monies for that event. The class will be corrected, but no further action will be taken.

IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SHOOTER TO VERIFY ALL ENTRY INFORMATION BEFORE LEAVING THE REGISTRATION AREA.

Eligibility and Classification

1. All participants must be current members of the NSSA.
2. Shooters must present their classification/shoot record card with all scores shot prior to current date properly and legibly recorded.
3. **NOTICE:** AAA class will only be offered if FIVE (5) or more shooters participate!
4. Teams are not required to shoot shoulder-to-shoulder.
5. A participant’s HOA class will not be lower than his or her lowest gun class.

Registration

1. Registration hours are as follows: Friday, May 31st, 12 – 6 PM. Saturday and Sunday registration begins at 8 AM.
2. Shooters participating in fewer than the entire 4-gun Program will be scheduled as near to requested times as possible, but must be accommodated at the convenience of the shoot management by necessity.
3. Entry for any HOA event requires registration and payment of all entry fees for all events prior to firing in the first gauge of the event the shooter wishes to enter.
4. There will be no refunds for withdrawals, except in the case of extreme emergencies. There will be no refunds for withdrawal due to adverse weather conditions.

5. Anyone entering an event for which they are not eligible will not be given a refund if the error is not discovered until after they have shot the event.

Shooting Procedures

1. Current NSSA rules will be used throughout the tournament, unless otherwise stated in the program or posted in the registration area.
2. All events will be shot 100 targets on a field using the flight system. Each flight will have one hour and 20 minutes to shoot 100 targets. Each flight will start on time, and in the case of breakdown, slow squad, etc., shoot management reserves the right to move the squad to a practice field. Any squad or shooter not ready when called will be placed on a space available basis. If space is not available, the squad or shooters will not be able to shoot the event. No refunds will be issued in these cases.
3. All changes to a squad line up must be made at registration prior to shooting the event. Any changes made on the field without the permission of shoot management will result in disqualification of those participants for that event.
4. **Proof shells will be provided by the host club.**

Shoot-offs and Ties

Shoot-offs will be held as soon as possible after the completion of the event. It is the responsibility of the shooter to determine the shoot-off in which he or she may be involved on any particular day. The shooter forfeits all rights if absent at the time the shoot-off is called. In the event of impending ominous weather conditions, breakdowns, or other reasons which would make the conduct of regulation shoot-offs unadvisable, shoot management reserves the right to substitute any procedure that it may deem desirable, and notice of such changes will be given as soon as possible.

Shoot-off Order (Barring Weather Delays)

Friday Evening:	Doubles
Saturday Evening:	12 and 20 Gauge
Sunday Evening:	28 Gauge, .410 Bore, and HOA

PLEASE NOTE: TO SHORTEN THE LENGTH OF SHOOT-OFFS, ALL COMPETITORS MUST BRING TWO (2) BOXES OF AMMUNITION TO THE SHOOT-OFFS.

1. Ties for Gun CH, RU, 3rd, and Class 1, 2, 3 in all Guns, Dbls, and HOA will be shot off. All others are decided by long run.
2. Concurrent (Age, Collegiate, etc) ties for Ch, RU, and 3rd will be shot off. All others are decided by long run.
3. Concurrent (Ladies, 2-man & 5-man Teams) ties for CH, RU, 3rd, will be shot off. All others are decided by long run.
4. Long runs in all guns and Dbls. will be decided from the front or back scoring of that gun. Long runs for HOA will be decided by using the scoring from the front of the 12 gauge and the back of the 410 bore.

Shoot-off Procedures

- **12, 20, 28, .410, and Doubles:** Doubles Station 3, 4, and 5 – Miss and out by station using NSSA rules for procedures for shoot-offs.
- **HOA:** Will be shot using the .410 bore. Shoot-Off will consist of Doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5 – Miss and out by station using NSSA rules for shoot-offs.

Other Information:

1. All payouts will be mailed.
2. Shoot management reserves the right to change, cancel, or postpone any part of the program.
3. Shoot management reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any participant who annoys, endangers, or interferes with the harmony of the shoot.
4. Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accidents or loss of property occurring on the Red Eagle Skeet Club property.

Offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA (by Class – ties divide)

HANDICAP OPTION: Entry Fee \$10.00 per event

Offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA

Maximum Score 100 – ties divide

12 GA BCDE OPTIONS: Entry fee \$10.00 per event.

Offered in 12 gauge event only for shooters in B, C, D, or E Class. All shooters shooting a perfect round of 25 in any round of 12 GA will be eligible to split the pot.

LEWIS CLASS OPTION: Entry Fee \$10.00 per event

Offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA - 1 Class for every 10 entries, ties split

100 STRAIGHT POT: Entry Fee \$10.00 – All 100's split pot

CERTIFICATES awarded for Class 1st through 6th in: DBLS, 12, 20, 28, .410, AND HOA and all Concurrent winners (1st through 3rd place)

BUCKLES will be awarded to HOA CH, RU, and 3rd; Class HOA Champions (AAA – E) and Gun Champions (1st – 3rd) in: DBLS, 12, 20, 28, and .410

Trophies will be awarded to class champions in: DBLS, 12, 20, 28, and .410
