

# ORLANDO BAND TRIP NOTES

## LUGGAGE:

1. You may bring (1) carry on 10" x 16" x 24 " or smaller as your primary luggage that would go in the overhead bin inside the airplane.
2. You may bring an additional "personal bag" like a purse, back-pack, etc. This must be smaller than 18.5" x 8.5" x 13.5 "
3. If you need additional luggage, then you may check a bag for free when we arrive at the airport to go under the plane. However, understand we are discouraging this for the group because it slows down the check-in and arrival process. Only if you can't fit what you need for the trip in carry-ons.

**NOTE:** STUDENTS PLEASE BRING YOUR UNIFORM BAGS, MARCHING SHOES, AND BLACK SOCKS TO REHEARSAL ON 4/17. THESE WILL BE SENT ON THE BAND TRAILER TO ORLANDO ON MONDAY, 4/22, ALONG WITH THE LARGER INSTRUMENTS.

## INSTRUMENTS:

1. All instruments except Flutes and Clarinets will be shipped on the band trailer. Flutes and clarinets you need to pack your instrument in your luggage / carry on.
2. Instruments will be loaded on the trailer on Monday, 4/22, in the afternoon.

## WHAT TO BRING:

1. Comfortable tennis shoes, shorts, and t-shirts! There will be lots of walking!!
2. Sunblock, hats, sunglasses, etc.
3. Photo ID for the airport.
4. Money for breakfast snack in route and for dinner in route on way home (all other meals are pre-paid for). Money for any souvenirs, etc.
5. Good attitudes! ☺

## WHAT NOT TO BRING:

1. The three I's: Nothing illegal, intoxicating, or immoral!! You will be sent home at your own expense.
2. Any non-school trip appropriate apparel.
3. Game systems for the hotel rooms, or anything that would connect to the TV.
