## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Good morning and welcome to Immanuel Baptist Church. What a wonderful place to be on a Sunday morning. We just recently passed our two-year mark of worshipping in this building but it actually seems like it has only been a few weeks. Time passes so quickly anymore. Thank you for being here with us this morning to worship our Lord.

As you can see, we are celebrating the Lord's Supper this morning during our service. This is a special time of remembrance as we do this to honor the Lord. This is one of the two ordinances we observe, with the other being baptism. The elements of this Supper are the bread and the cup which our Deacons will distribute this morning. We practice *"open communion"* here at Immanuel which means that you do not have to be a member of our church in order to participate in the Supper with us. All who are born again believers in Christ Jesus as their Savior may join with us.

Please remember to mark your calendars for one week from tonight as we will have another Evening of Prayer at 6:00 PM in the Chapel. This will be a time dedicated to prayer individually and collectively. Please plan to attend this very important service.

Over the course of the past couple of weeks I have had some questions about church membership and the importance of it. Let me begin with this comment, church membership is for believers, those who are part of the Family of God. While church membership is not a requirement for salvation, the Bible clearly talks about the early church and who was part of it and who was not. In the book of Acts, we read of the history of the early church and how it grew and people were added to it.
