Over the past few weeks there have been some updates on the different buildings in my care as pastor. A new door, lock, and motion light was installed at the Sigel Hall. This lock has a keypad and if you are in need of the code, please contact me. The lock also has a traditional key hole and copies of this key are available from Fr. Urban. A motion light was installed at the Sigel Hall as well. A motion light has been installed above the rectory door at Lesterville. This will be helpful to deter any ill-will towards the buildings and they will serve a practical purpose for the evenings. A new air handler and air conditioning unit was installed at the rectory in Tabor. A fire pit will be installed at the rectory in Tabor and my hope is to be out there once or twice a week to enjoy the time outside once the temperature improves. If you see me at the fire pit or on the porch, feel free to stop by for a visit. If you signed up for a Catholic Rural Life Prayer Book, please pick them up at your convenience. There is a sheet to indicate that you have paid and picked up your book. The cost is \$16.75 and checks can be made out to Saint Wenceslaus Parish.

There is an untapped resource in the Church called the Patristic writers. These writers wrote in Latin and/or Greek and the earliest of them had direct contact with the apostles. The last of this group of writers would be Saint Augustine who died in the year 430. One of these writers, Saint Justin, recorded what the worship of the early Church looked like and the following is drawn from the Catechism of the Catholic Church paragraph #1345: "On the day we call the day of the sun, all who dwell in the city or country gather in the same place. The memoirs of the apostles and the writings of the prophets are read, as much as time permits. When the reader has finished, he who presides over those gathered admonishes and challenges them to imitate these beautiful things. Then we all rise together and offer prayers for ourselves...and for all others, wherever they may be, so that we may be found righteous by our life and actions, and faithful to the commandments, so as to obtain eternal salvation. When the prayers are concluded we exchange the kiss. Then someone brings bread and a cup of water and wine mixed together to him who presides over the brethren. He takes them and offers praise and glory to the Father of the universe, through the name of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and for a considerable time he gives thanks (in Greek: eucharistian) that we have been judged worthy of these gifts. When he has concluded the prayers and thanksgivings, all present give voice to an acclamation by saying: 'Amen.' When he who presides has given thanks and the people have responded, those whom we call deacons give to those present the "eucharisted" bread, wine and water and take them to those who are absent."

Reading this account gives me the chills because of how close our worship in 2019 compares with the worship of the early Church in the year 155. I think that this is why it is important to hold on to and promote Catholic worship as the Church has handed it down to us over the course of 2000 years. Our job as Catholics is to participate in the life of the Church as we are called and gifted by our heavenly Father.

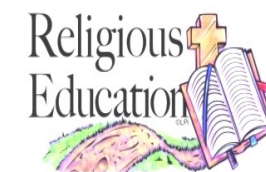
