The growth of the school can be tracked from its humble beginnings in a small rented room

with just three students to the internationally recognized institute that it is today. A fully

functional State Board affiliated school as well as a registered society; this school has grown

from strength to strength under the able governance of our board of trustees, steered by our

passionate team of qualified teachers and staff.

Our mission has been to Educate, Train and Rehabilitate the Hearing Impaired, Intellectually

Challenged, Deaf-blind and Differently Able children and to help them avail all the privileges

that are available to the able bodied.

The Institute presently has a number of programmes that are being undertaken

simultaneously, some of which are;

• The Senior Secondary School affiliated to the State Board [in Chennai].

• The Rural Extension Project in Kelambakkam [34kms away from Chennai City, in

Kanchipuram District].

We take in students from varying economic backgrounds and fully support their much needed

education and also provide hostel facilities for our outstation hearing impaired students.



We now have a total of 110 students and as opposed to a normal school where the student to teacher ratio is a minimum of 35: 1, we, being an institute for the disabled, have maintained a ratio of 3:1 and sometimes even less depending on the disability. As we continue to progress and endeavor for the best of the best, we find that the only possible set back is the need for financial support, quite mandatory for such types of philanthropic institutions. We depend on donations and grants for our economically backward students as we treat all children as equals.

It is important to us that no child is deprived of quality education and other benefits simply for lack of monetary resources but, the actual revenue collected from each class is almost negligible and doesn't even begin to cover the basic running expenses.

One of our main challenges was to reward our teachers equivalent to their abilities which we still have not achieved satisfactory levels.

ONLINE CLASSES DURING PANDEMIC:

We are able to maintain the high standards of academic excellence mainly due to the extraordinary contribution from the staff's, who are highly qualified & experienced. All the staffs continued to teach these children with so much of personal care & dedication even during pandemic / Covid time, that they went out of their way to teach children online some directly some through their parents as per the convenience of the parents & children as most of them had limitations with their networking.

Unlike various other professions where people seek different working environment on account of financial benefits, our teachers have always focused only on the development of the child & never their personal benefits.

impairment, Intellectually Disabled, Multiple Disabilities & Deafblind. She is working with us

for the last 37 years & indeed a proud moment for all of us @ Clarke School on her recognition

with this award.

Mrs.Jayanthi Narayanan's exceptional commitment reflected even during the pandemic /

Covid time, through her efforts to reach out to many parents (Not only of Clarke School but

others too). She has to her credit 40 videos guiding parents, trainees, special educators to learn

& adapt training / teaching methods for the children with special needs.

Considering that, we are reaching 52 years of service, we would like to reward these teachers

with the onetime pay-out & we seek your support with your contribution to the welfare fund.

Presently we are not able to cover the cost of expenditure of the total cost although we have

always maintained a principle of keeping the managerial roles, purely advisory and not

revenue oriented. As such, we have shortfall of INR 40 Lakhs to continue our existing projects.

This imbalance of our revenues and expenditure is a stumbling block in the development of

the school. We need to bridge the gap of this financial restraint. In fact we don't have any

resources to develop & maintain the infrastructural needs too.

Please note that our school is registered under the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act XXI

of 1960, S.No. 237 of 1972 and donations to our organization are exempted from Income tax

under Sec. 80 G. We also have a valid permanent FCRA number given to us by the Ministry
