Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles, foot passengers, pedal cycles and equestrians that length of Lower Street which extends from its junction with Dyrham Road/Doynton Lane to its junction with Sands Hill.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon Openreach works requiring access to underground structure for cabling to restore service and will be operative from the 21 October 2020 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of 1 day's duration.
