
Rules to becoming a Mentee

1. No more than three (3) unexcused absences from program functions.
2. Mentees are not to ridicule or tease, through mockery, another Mentee or Mentor at any time.
3. Mentees are to show proper respect to Mentors in their speech and behavior.
4. There will be zero tolerance for fighting, displaying gang signs and affiliation, consumption of alcohol or drugs, expulsion from school, or similar detrimental behavior deemed unacceptable.

Becoming a Mentor

Our mentors focus on helping young men develop into responsible adults. Lessons taught by the mentors provide models for what is acceptable behavior in society.

Qualifications to Become a Mentor

1. On a full-time basis, attend college, work as an employee, or operate a business.
2. Be at least 21 years old.
3. Be willing to make a firm commitment to the program from October to May.
4. No history of criminal charges, past or present, especially involving children.
5. Exhibit patience in dealing with young men that are developing into men and learning how to become adults.

Process to Becoming a Mentor

1. Meet the qualifications listed above and a mentor application.
2. Pass a background investigation.
3. Complete an in-person interview.
4. Attend training sessions.

Rules and Regulations:

1. No more than three (3) unexcused absences from program functions.
2. Show discretion in speech and actions at all times.
3. Only make contact with mentees during group settings.
4. Never insult, ridicule, or harm a mentee(s).
5. Maintain a professional attitude at all times.
6. Respect that mentees are young men shaping their ideas on life and their opinions may be different than yours.
