### They have 3 tiers

Tier 1: All students have access to tier 1 services

- Check ins on the students' emotions.
- Monthly themes: Sept/Start w/Hello, Oct/ National Stop Bullying Day, Nov/Dec: Kindness and Gratitude.
- Elevo PE-Weekly Characteristics: Leadership, Energy, Integrity
- Classrooms Lesson: Zones/regulations, emotional intelligence, Class Needs
- Teacher Check ins
- Conflict Resolution
- Lunch Bunch: Social skills through games. Students can come to the MPR and eat lunch and discuss topics about how they can be better at solving problems on their own.

Tier 2: Is for students who might need a little more support. They can be having a small struggle so they would check in with this student more often. It is a set 5 sessions and would require parent approval.

Short term individual counseling session and referrals to outside counseling, behavior intervention, etc.

Will need a referral for session
