St. Peter's in Galicantu,
which is built over the
site of the house of the
High Priest Caiaphas
and the stone pit

where Jesus was held. Three times, Peter also denied knowing Jesus near this same place.

We will also visit the Upper Room. End the day by visiting the Garden Tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

11/7, Day 5, \$ Early morning start. Drive south along the Dead Sea. Take a cable-car to the top of Masada to view the fortress of Herod. You will also visit Ein Gedi, and then proceed to the

ruins of the ancient Essene settlement at Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Overnight in Jerusalem.



11/8, Day 6, \$ Begin the day by visiting the Temple Mount. You will then drive to Bethlehem

area to visit the Shepherd's Field and the Church of the Nativity. Enjoy lunch at the Grotto. Overnight in Jerusalem.

11/9, Day 7, M Begin the day by visiting Pool of Bethesda and St. Anne's. You will then walk through the Old City of Jerusalem, Way of the Cross, ending in the Holy Sepulchre. After lunch, visit the friends of Zion Museum. Overnight in Jerusalem.

We will also take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and enjoy a St. Peter's Fish lunch. Overnight in Galilee.

11/12, Day 10, TH Visit Caesarea Philippi and Tel Dan. After lunch, you will go to Jordan River-Yardenit Baptismal. Overnight in Galilee.



11/13, Day 11, F Check out of the hotel. Begin the day by visiting Megiddo, with the most impressive water system. You will then continue to Mt. Carmel. Caesarea Maritime National Park and the aqueduct will be the last stop of the day. Continue to Jaffa for your farewell dinner and then transfer to hotel in Tel Aviv for overnight or flight back to the U.S.
