# 1. <u>RESOLUTION: ORDINANCE DECLARING A ROAD CLOSURE FOR THE</u> 2021 WALKERTOWN CHRISTMAS PARADE

Doc: The request for road closure comes from the Civic Club. If you recall the last parade 2 years ago, as many as 5 intersections were unmanned. Scott: Deputy Leonard has taken point on going to the fire department for help.

Doc: We'll need help at 5 intersections on Main.

Scott: We will use fire trucks at Main & 66 and Harley Drive. Doc: We could use deputies but they won't come for free.

Peggy: What is the cost?

Scott: Hustle hours are \$35 per hour with a 3 hour minimum.

Doc: Fire Department didn't show up 2 years ago.

Wesley: Will the Civic Club offset costs?

Scott: No, they are the organizers. The Town authorizes the road closure so that responsibility falls to the Town.

Wesley: Probably have a larger crowd this year.

People followed the last float 2 years ago.

Scott: Those were mostly parked at the library and elementary school. Deputy Leonard will follow the end of the parade.

Peggy: The parade is a civic event. Why not use the Recreation Fund? We didn't spend any on the Fall Festival this year. \$420 would pay for 4 deputies.

Doc: 5 deputies would be \$525.

Wesley: Money well spent. Would Jason line up the deputies?

Scott: I'm sure he would. We will have better assistance this year with the fire department and Jason coordinating.
