**Almighty and ever-living God, you anointed your beloved Son to be priest and sovereign forever. Grant that all the people of the earth, now divided by the power of sin, may be united by the glorious and gentle rule of Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen**

**First Lesson Isaiah 51:4-6** [4](#) "Give attention to me, my people, and give ear to me, my nation; for a law will go out from me, and I will set my justice for a light to the peoples.[5](#) My righteousness draws near, my salvation has gone out, and my arms will judge the peoples; the coastlands hope for me, and for my arm they wait.[6](#) Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look at the earth beneath; for the heavens vanish like smoke, the earth will wear out like a garment, and they who dwell in it will die in like manner; but my salvation will be forever, and my righteousness will never be dismayed.

**Second Lesson Jude 1:20-25** [20](#) But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit,[21](#) keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that leads to eternal life. [22](#) And have mercy on those who doubt;[23](#) save others by snatching them out of the fire; to others show mercy with fear, hating even the garment stained by the flesh.[24](#) Now to him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of his glory with great joy,[25](#) to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.

**Gospel Mark 13:24-37** [24](#) "But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light,[25](#) and the stars will be falling from heaven, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken.[26](#) And then they will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory.[27](#) And then he will send out the angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of heaven[28](#) "From the fig tree learn its lesson: as soon as its branch becomes tender and puts out its leaves, you know that summer is near.[29](#) So also, when you see these things taking place, you know that he is near, at the very gates.[30](#) Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place.[31](#) Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.[32](#) "But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.[33](#) Be on guard, keep awake. For you do not know when the time will come.[34](#) It is like a man going on a journey, when he leaves home and puts his servants in charge, each with his work, and commands the doorkeeper to stay awake.[35](#) Therefore stay awake--for you do not know when the master of the house will come, in the evening, or at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or in the morning--[36](#) lest he come suddenly and find you asleep.[37](#) And what I say to you I say to all: Stay awake."
