We obtained 5 fleet cards, and they were issued to the Chief, Deputy & Assistant Chiefs, the Captain and 1 card is held by the Commissioners in the safe.

The generator major PM is scheduled for this Friday July 28th. Mr. Myronowskyj will be present while they perform the work.
