MEMBER NEWS

The Board had accepted the following proposal from The Dues Committee. This was discussed at the June 7th, 2021 Meeting and was voted on at the July 5th Membership Meeting.

This proposal was voted down by the membership.

- Member Dues \$150, \$25 of which would go to a major/capital improvement fund
- Spouse Dues \$50, \$25 of which would go to a major/capital improvement fund
- Senior dues \$75, \$25 of which would go to a major/capital improvement fund
- \$25 fee for trailer/launch sticker, all of which will be for dock maintenance and repairs. Note: this \$25 fee is per member (who requests a trailer/launch sticker), NOT per boat.
- The initiation fee will remain \$75

The Board has accepted the following proposal from the Dues Committee, to be discussed at the August 1st, 2021 Membership meeting and will be voted on at the September 13th, 2021 Membership meeting.

- Single Member dues \$125
- Spouse dues \$50

New Membership Applications: Previously all new membership applications taken in after the first membership meeting in August were accepted for the rest of the current year through the following year. Effective Immediately. The Board has changed this date to the first Membership meeting in OCTOBER. All new membership applications taken in August and September are due for renewal by December 31st per the by-laws.
