Residents are encouraged to attend and become involved and be informed.

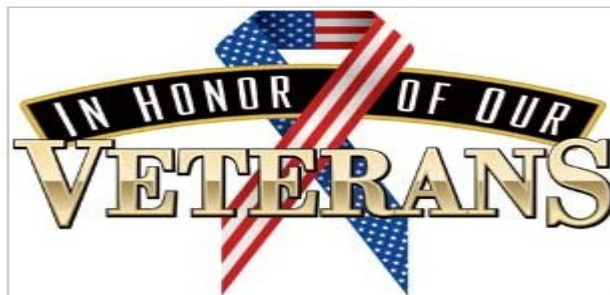

Resident Notice:

At our September meeting the Village Board has changed the Zoning to reflect the resurfacing of existing driveways at a \$75 flat fee which includes 1 inspection. We have also changed the code for establishing a new driveway at a \$150 flat fee for 2 inspections, one pre-work and 1 post-work. Any driveway work performed in the street right-of-way is also subject to cost and requirements identified in Section 7 Construction of Facilities in the Rights-of-Way in “CHAPTER 27 - PUBLIC PARKS AND PUBLIC WAYS” of THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF SHERIDAN which includes the cost of review by the Village Engineer and the driveway contractor providing proof on insurance to the Village of Sheridan prior to performing any work within the street right-of-way.

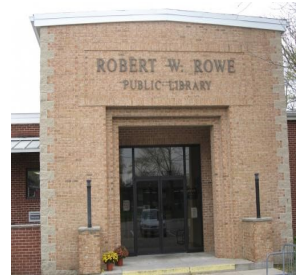
