



POSITION TITLE: Flight Director (Part-Time)

POSITION SUMMARY:

Part-time Challenger Flight Directors conduct educational STEM programs year-round for students preK - 12th grade. Programs consist of simulated space missions and hands-on workshops held at the Peoria Center, or community STEM events and assemblies held at local schools and libraries. Number of hours per week will vary depending on programs scheduled that week, but is not to exceed 30 hours.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Learn and conduct Challenger Space Center educational programming including simulated space missions, workshops, outreach, and e-missions
- Assist in program preparation and clean-up
- Perform other related duties as assigned and necessary

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be 18 years or older
- Excellent presentation, oral and written communication skills, dynamic, outgoing, and creative personality
- Education background helpful, especially experience with preK-12 students
- Science, engineering, math and/or technology background a plus
- Ability to work independently as well as part of a team
- Ability to work weekdays (usually sometime between 9:00am and 4:00pm) for 2-6 hours at a time up to several days a week, plus occasional weekends and early evenings
- Ability to travel to Challenger Space Center and to local schools and libraries
- Ability to convey program materials and equipment to and from program locations, plus set up and clean up
