### FROM THE SUPERVISOR

We are getting near completion on the park improvements at the Fred Meiselbach Park located on Neuman Road near Pine River. As you recall the Township was awarded a \$75,000 grant from the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. We broke ground in July & hope to have the last couple of finishing touches done before winter, which include solar powered LED lighting and new fencing. New playground equipment of Universal Access Design and recycled materials; and a 500-foot asphalt pathway that will provide barrier-free access to the playground equipment and other park amenities have been installed. Pictures are located within the newsletter. The Ribbon Cutting Ceremony will be Friday, October 25<sup>th</sup> at noon. All residents are welcome to attend.

The overlay on Allington Road from the funds awarded from the Local Road System Funding Program with St Clair County Road Commission was completed this past summer. New culverts were put in near Allington & Trumble Road crossing area, as well.

Many ditching projects have been completed. Six safety approaches will also be completed this year. The areas include the following roads: Klettner at Wadhams, Carriage Lane at Rattle Run, Drexler at Mayer, Frith at Mayer, Trumble at Wadhams (east side) and Trumble at Wadhams (west side).

Once again, we have applied to the Road Commission for the Local Road System Funding Program for work to be done in 2020. The grant is a matching fund program. If we are approved for the grant, overlay on Neuman between Wadhams & Kennedy will be done.

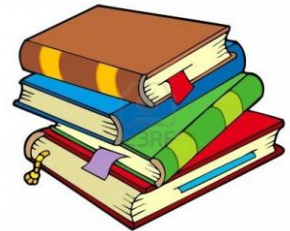
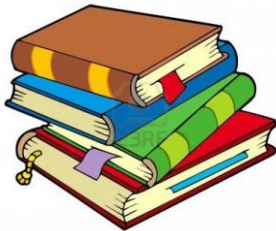

You can contact Marcotte with questions on recycling or go to our website for the list of what is acceptable. Recycle bins are sold at the Township Hall. They cost \$10.00 each. You can purchase one from us or use your own.

For residents that have yard waste included (east of Range Road), the service will end the last Monday in November. Yard waste will only be collected in compostable paper bags or 33-gallon trash cans, no lids, marked with an "X" not weighing more than 40 pounds. All branches must be tied and bundled with string or twine and be in 4 feet lengths or less, no bigger than 2" in diameter.
