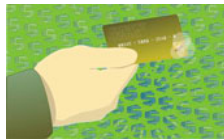

AUTHORIZATION REQUIREMENT! **TO RECEIVE E-MAIL**

E-mail such as the Tale-Lite is sent out presently by private personal computers, a cumbersome and onerous procedure that circumvents privacy restrictions that govern such bulk/commercial mailing. To rectify these deficiencies and bring us in line with current standards, we have contracted with a web hosting service to handle our mailings and other processes. However, to comply with said privacy regulations, bulk/commercial senders of e-mail must first have prior authorisation from the recipient. Accordingly, the ATSSA has posted a simple electronic form on its web site to facilitate such an authorization.
