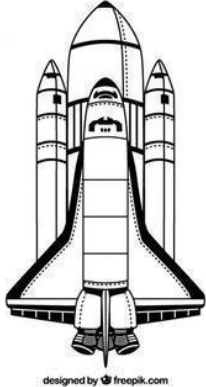

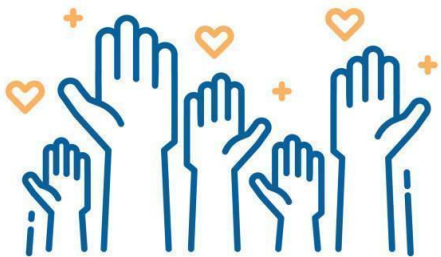

This is a challenge but also an adventure too. You will need to use your creativity and come up with an interesting way to display your chosen block and color.

Pull from your stash or go shopping, good excuse to do that right!

Rules of the road

1. Choose a Block pattern from the box
2. Choose color/crayon from the bag
3. If for some reason you don't like the block pattern you drew you can swap it for another at the cost of a dollar\$
4. If for some reason you don't like your color you drew same thing swap it for a dollar\$.
5. No limit on how many times you swap your color or your block pattern so come prepared with a few extra dollars.

The challenge will need to be turned in at the August meeting. Bring back your block pattern and color with your block wall hanging place matt table runner or maybe something different. There will be tickets drawn for a chance to pick something from the treasure box. Someone will win a special prize for the most creative entry. Return with this letter of participation.
