## The Mycestro Smart Ring

This wearable 3D printed mouse that you can wear on your finger and operate a computer using gestures and thumb actions. Mycestro connects to your computer, tablet, or other devices by Bluetooth wireless connection. The computer to be controlled requires a USB dongle for Mycestro to work. You can control your computer from up to 10 meters (30 ft) away.

Mycestro comes with a desktop app, which allows you to customize all the details of your mouse and cursor by using natural gestures. It works with Windows and Apple devices.



# **Finger Input Device**

For people with functional loss like muscle weakness, the finger input brings the support needed. The 3D printed shape not only is light, but gives the easiness of mount and also elegance in action. The circle patterns are inspired by Fibonacci number. The device tip has a particular shape that enables natural input operation, so that it will make you feel so smooth.

### **Eating Utensil Holder**

The finger holder is for people who feel the difficulty of holding a spoon or fork. Grip action is not required because a side clip tightly holds the spoon or fork instead of you. Able to use a standard spoon with a thickness of around 3mm (handle). The holder fits around fingers and is fixed securely to a hand. This can be fitted to a variety of finger sizes because of its unique shape.
