

Dr. Malchiodi is an art therapist, expressive arts therapist and clinical mental health counselor as well as a recognized authority on art therapy with children, adults, and families.

She has given more than 400 presentations on art therapy and has published numerous articles, chapters, and books, including What to Do When Children Clam Up in Psychotherapy, Understanding Children's Drawings, Handbook of Art Therapy (2nd ed.), Trauma-Informed Practices with Children and Adolescents, Creative Arts and Play Therapy for Attachment Problems, and Creative Interventions with Traumatized Children (2nd ed.).

Dr. Malchiodi is a visiting professor at universities in the United States and internationally and is the founder and executive director of Trauma-Informed Practices and Expressive Arts Therapy Institute. She has worked with a variety of community, national and international agencies, particularly on the use of art therapy for trauma intervention, disaster relief, mental health, medical illness, and prevention.

Dr. Malchiodi has served on the boards of many professional organizations including the American Counseling Association, Art Therapy Without Borders, American Art Therapy Association, and Association for Humanistic Counseling; she currently serves on the journal editorial boards of Arts in Psychotherapy, Creative Arts in Education and Therapy (China), and Academic Journal of Creative Art Therapies (Israel). A passionate advocate for the role of the arts in health, art therapy and expressive arts, Dr. Malchiodi is a blogger for Psychology Today with a readership of over 4 million.

Description

Trauma-informed expressive arts and play therapy integrates neurodevelopmental knowledge and the sensory qualities of the arts in trauma including the following: 1) how the mind and body respond to traumatic events; 2) recognition that symptoms are adaptive coping strategies rather than pathology; 3) emphasis on cultural sensitivity and empowerment; and 4) helping to move individuals from being not only survivors, but ultimately to becoming "thrivers" through skill building, support networks, and resilience enhancement. During this three-day course, participants will learn how to apply expressive arts within the framework of play therapy with children, adolescents and families, with an emphasis on neurodevelopment; the importance of safety and the window of tolerance in creative intervention; self-regulation approaches; body-resourcing; and the role of resilience and posttraumatic growth in trauma reparation and recovery. Attendees will experience a variety of creative interventions in order to learn how to integrate these approaches in work with traumatized children, youth, families and groups.

Participants attending all 3 days will get a Trauma Informed Expressive Arts Therapy Level 1 Certificate.
