President's Message

Tournament Golf is back! It was great to see such a large turnout for our first tournament back from our three-month break. Although we missed three tournaments and the Laughlin Getaway, members were ready to play tournament golf!

Some minor changes on how check-in was run, but overall things went very smooth. Thank you all for your patience that allowed us to make the best of our new normal for the time being.

El Prado Golf Course did an amazing job of getting the course set up and have enough carts for our players on both courses.

One major takeaway from our first tournament is how relaxed we all have been from not playing tournament golf. We must address a few of these things moving forward for tournaments and skins games.

First and foremost, the rules of golf have not changed because of Covid19. Normal rules of golf are still the same, even during the Covid19 quarantine. Some courses may have changed their local rules, so be sure and know those local rules. You must hole your ball out in tournament play. Hitting the stick is NOT holing the ball out. EPMC has made one minor temporary rule change to date for all club events. You MAY play lift, clean and place in the bunkers only, while placing the ball no closer to the hole. It is a local rule only, and if you play somewhere else, follow their local rules. We DO NOT allow you to lift the ball out of the bunker to play your ball.

Secondly, the normal procedures for signing a card by both the scorer and the player along with the date has not changed. Circling all birdies. This applies to skins games, and to tournaments. Failure to do any of these things on your scorecard WILL result in a DQ or loss of your skin.

At all tournaments, we have a rules sheet for that tournament. If you are unsure about how to play the format, please refer to the rules sheet, and/or ask a board member. If you ask a player in your group and are given inaccurate information that causes you to play it wrong, then you are to blame. Playing competitors are not always right and will not save you from being incorrect. If you have are not sure of which way to play or score a particular shot that is not addressed, then play two balls, and ask at scoring when you get in, before you sign and turn in your scorecard.

It's worth mentioning, that you SHALL NOT share information with your playing partners as to what club to hit, or what the break or wind might be doing. This applies to non-partner tournament play as well as skin's games. We still have some members that play some partner games within the confines of skin's games and are helping to read each other's putts or sharing club usage in certain situations. This MUST STOP. The field must be protected. Many are doing this out of habit. So, other partners should just mention it when they see it happen. For instance, a player putting on the same line, so a "partner" can see the putt, even though they are inside the partner. Please do your part to protect the field and all the other players that don't have someone to share information with.

It's up to all of us to play the game by the rules and to ensure others around us do the same. If you have any questions about the rules or a ruling, please ask a board member, or Kevin or Art in the shop. If we don't have the answer, we will get it for you.

Please continue to do your part to keep us all safe from Covid19 so we can continue to play this awesome game!

We had a total payout of \$3,958. If you like bigger payouts make sure to play and encourage your buddies too. Check all the winners/winnings on the result section. Congratulations to all the winners.

Please take the time to know the Conditions/Rules and make sure your own card is marked properly before you turn it in. If you are in doubt, please ask your questions of the Scorekeeper before signing and handing in your card. Things can be resolved AND THEN YOU MUST SIGN YOUR SCORECARD. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN **DISQUALIFICATION.**

Skins and Closest to pin checks are prepared about a week after the tournament by Richard Lizarraga. You can pick up your check on Saturday at the next skins game or wait for the snail mail and It takes two or three weeks to get your check in the mail so be patient.

Please check the entire results in the newsletter. At any time, you can hand your **El Prado Mens Club script card** to the golf shop personnel and check your script balances. I would suggest that you check your balances the following week or two after the competition to ensure everything is OK.

Thanks again to Kevin for manning the scoreboard and helping with all the scoreboard results.

Remember, we are the members of El Prado Mens Club and this is our home course. Take care of your divots, repair ball marks, fix pitch marks, drive your carts through the rough instead of the fairways. Play quickly and keep up with the group in front of you. On July 18th, our next tournament will be a 2 Man Invitational Tournament. We usually get a large field for this event so make sure you find your partner and get your entry in early.
