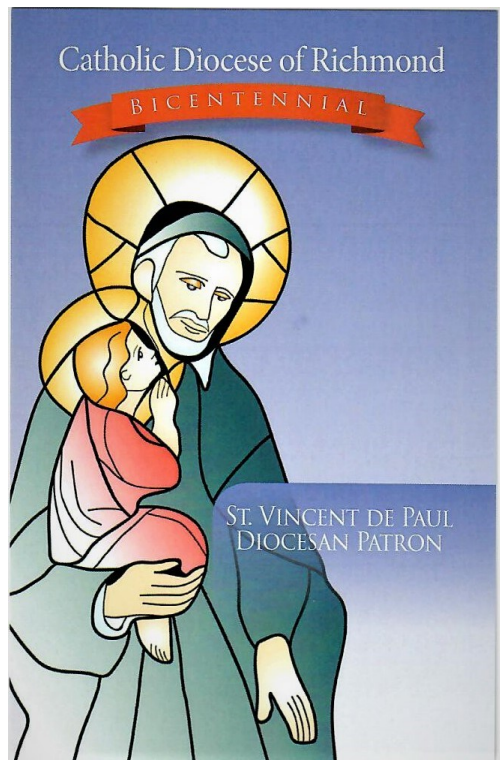
In Hebron, David is hailed as king by all the tribes of Israel.
