

President, Ward called the meeting to order.

### **Announcements:**

We lost a wonderful member with the passing of Cecil Posey. Several club members traveled to Fredericksburg to pay their respects. Ward said he always appreciated his conversations with Cecil and enjoyed his Nova which reminded him of his family car. Ward announced we have several changes in the club. Brent and Sherry have resigned their positions of Secretary and Car Show committee chair. Ward said I've always tried to be open and honest with everyone in the club and I think I have. It has never been in my character to be underhanded. Ward remarked that Brent and Sherry had done a number of remarkable things that have benefited our club.

### **Note to minutes:**

He doesn't recall saying to Charlene "Charlene, I just can't help that" in the By-Laws discussion. 


