ELIGIBILITY

Youth ages 16-20 who:

- are currently in Foster Care (or were on their 16th birthday)
- are placed in an out-of-home probation placement (or were on their 16th birthday)
- are in a Kin-Gap placement (or were on their 16th birthday)

PROGRAMS

1. Working with an Education and Employment Specialist (EE)
2. High School Completion Program (First Foundation)
3. Drop In Hours/Workshops/Events
4. Permanency Services
5. YES! Internship Program

EMPLOYMENT AND EDUCATION SPECIALISTS

- Assist with education and employment goals
- Meet 2x a month with an EE
- Facilitate weekly workshops on housing, education, employment and healthy living skills on Tuesday from 4pm-6pm at ILSP

FIRST FOUNDATION

- First Foundation youth are working towards completion of their high school diploma or GED
- Meet 4x a month alternating between case management support and workshops
- Workshops focus on educational success
- Provide financial support for textbooks, testing fees and college app fees

YES! INTERNSHIP

- Minimum of 10 hours a week of a paid internship
- Must attend job readiness workshop every Thursday, from 4pm-6pm at ILSP
- Earn a minimum wage salary (\$14/hour)
- Youth need to have a valid ID and Social Security card to participate
- YES! applications can be filled out at ILSP

PERMANENCY

Permanency Counselors support with:

- Reconnecting with family and natural supports
- Community engagement
- Heritage and genetic testing
- Creating positive support networks
