Bridge dedication at York IWL

Senator Kristin Phillips-Hill (R-York) successfully sponsored legislation to re-name the Inners Creek Bridge on Iron Stone Hill Rd. in honor of Cpl. Michael Cohen, a Dallastown graduate who was killed in action on November 22, 2004 in Fallujah, Iraq. On Saturday, October 24th, starting at 11am, we will be hosting the dedication ceremony on the club grounds, using the pavilions and a canopy near the playground. The front field will be used for parking. By family request, this will be a modest ceremony, and we should consider their wishes in using that section of the club grounds for that morning, please respect their space. Expect to see a crew setting up on Friday afternoon.



Are You Registered to Vote?

IWL encourages its members to get involved in the political process. The easiest and most effective way to do that is to vote! If you're not already a registered voter, now is the time to get registered. In Pennsylvania, the state has a "one-stop" web site (www.votespa.com) where you can register to vote, request a mail-in or absentee ballot, check on your voter registration status, find your polling place, etc. All voter registration applications must be received by Oct. 19, if you want to vote on Nov. 3. The upcoming elections will determine the decisions our local, state, and federal government make in the upcoming years. So remember, if you don't vote on Nov. 3, don't complain on Nov. 4!

Hi Juniors!

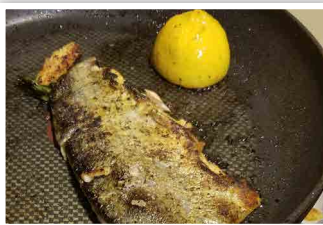

22LR **FIND OUT MORE** 12/13- We will be holding a 22 LR rifle funshoot on the front 3 ranges. Targets will be set anywhere from 25-200 yds. I recommend 25/50 yrd zero with iron sights or a scope will allow you to engage targets as far out as you like. This is a fun shoot, and NOT a match. It will have some close carnival style stages along with steel set at various distances out to 200 yards to see what your rifle can do. It will be a very laid back format with roaming groups moving from stage to stage as desired. As usual, chamber flags (weedwhacker line works great) and bags/cart are standard for movement between stages. \$20 adults and \$5 kids under 18 Please email broncolou@comcast if you have any questions. LAKE TONIAN



How exciting it has been to talk with all the members that have been enjoying the pond the last month! I haven't been able to fish it as much as I like to, but the few times I have been able to spend time there has been relaxing. The panfish have been caught fishing small pieces of worm on the bottom by a few youth. Bass are being caught on plastic worm baits; with reports of weights in the 1.5-2lb. range from bass that were released. I've been able to remove quite a few largemouth bass, (less than 13") by fishing 1.25" swimbaits, 2" crankbaits, 1/32oz. chenille jigs, and 1./16oz. hair jigs.

The fishing itself has proven to be spotty yet, with fish still holding in certain parts of the pond. So, if you aren't catching, work your way around to different areas until you find the fish; find one, there will be others close by.

Johnny Potter, age 12 is being highlighted this month with his contribution of helping to remove the over-populated bass. He has been spending time with his grandparents at the pond on the weekends; making memories he and his grandparents will cherish forever.

Reminder: ALL panfish are catch and release; please return any bluegill and/or crappie unharmed into the pond.
