## **CHECKLIST for YOUR Organization to consider HOSTING THE PARADE OF FLAGS:**

- ✓ Know Who We Are: Heritage Guides ask about us. Visit our website
  (www.heritageguides.org) so you have a very clear understanding of our business.
- ✓ **Display Location**: Outside lawn/landscape area at least 700 square feet.
- ✓ Clear\* soil condition: each cross is mounted on rebar that is placed 8" in the ground.
  Other tributes are on a sign post placed 6" in the ground.
- ✓ **Lights/ Illumination/Electrical Power:** Required for Flags to remain over night\*.
- ✓ Mowing: Mow prior NO mowing, line trimming, or blowing debris near the display.
- ✓ Vehicle Access: Clear area for a vehicle with a 10' enclosed trailer.\*
- ✓ **Tell Us Who You Are** and why you want to host the display.
- ✓ Responsibilities: 1.) Designate a point of contact to address display location, dates, times, and payment. 2.) Designate an on-site responsible person to handle the day to day responsibilities\*\*.
- ✓ **FEES:** \$150.00 to \$700.00 depending on set up and duration. *Non-Patriotic Holiday rates posted below*

\*Site Visit required. May be need water during drought conditions

\*\* In the event there is NOT a Responsible – ON SITE – person designate there will be a \$25 per day fee added.
