Buell Block at 366-378 Central St.

It was named for George E. Buell, a local prominent businessman, was built in 1878. It became the second home of the Odd Fellows. It is a three story brick building in the Queen Anne/ Victorian Romanesque style that later had a gabled two story rook added later. The building provided offices for various professions. Its basement was also utilized as manufacturing space, particularly for Rufus Bean's "Ready Binder" for pamphlets.
