PURPOSE:

To define the District's standard procedure for mutual aid move ups

RESPONSIBILITY:

All District Personnel

PROCEDURES:

All move ups shall be done on the quiet. If the apparatus is dispatched to a call, then the response may be upgraded as necessary.

8814 In Service (8814R Out of Service)

When 8814 is in service St. Charles County Dispatch and Alarm (Dispatch) will dispatch 8814 and assign the move up station. 8814 will move up and no additional personnel shall respond, with the exception of District officers. One district officer shall respond to serve as a duty officer. Any additional personnel should report the District station to staff the remaining apparatus.

8814R In Service (8814 Out of Service)

When 8814R is in service Dispatch will dispatch 8814 and assign the station to move up to. Prior to 8814R responding, all members shall go to the District station to staff the truck. The truck shall be staffed with the most qualified members available and respond as soon as possible.

Members at the station when 8814R responds shall stay and staff the remaining trucks. Any members still traveling when 8814R responds should then go to the move up station. Staffing on the truck may then change to allow for better qualified personnel. Riding in the truck to the move up station does not ensure you will remain on the truck. Members who are removed from the truck shall take the other member's POV and return to the District station to help staff the remaining trucks.

Changing of staff shall be at the discretion of the ranking officer or senior member.
