### **COVID Protocols for 2021-2022 Season**

The DDA wants you to be confident in knowing that we are taking precautions to prevent the spread of Covid-19. We believe that with the following protocols in place we can continue to enjoy dance safely.

## Screening:

\*If you are not feeling well, stay home. If you appear to be sick or show symptoms of being sick, your teacher may ask you to leave and return when you are feeling better. If you have recently been exposed to someone with Covid-19, please refrain from attending.

# **Personal Protective Equipment and Procedures:**

- \* Wash your hands and/or use hand sanitizer when you arrive.
- \*Alcohol based hand sanitizer will be available for use throughout the building.
- \* Everyone must wear a mask or face covering upon entering the studio. Mask must be worn the whole time while inside the building. Students 12 & older who are fully vaccinated may take off their mask during class/while on the wood floor only. Vaccination proof is required. This is the current studio policy and those who are unwilling to comply will not be able to attend.
- \* Any student that is fully vaccinated and would like to wear a mask, is welcome to do so.
- \* Waiting room seating has been limited.

### **Hygiene and Cleaning:**

- \* All chairs, doorknobs and commonly touched surfaces will be wiped down or sprayed in between classes.
- \* Any props used during class will be used by only one student and cleaned before next use.
