most often inhabits West Indian top-shell Cittarium pica



BLUE LAND CRAB Cardisoma guanhumi

in holes along trails & in moist areas, variable size & color



SALLY LIGHTFOOT CRAB *Grapsus grapsus*

fast, supratidal, on rocky shores and ramparts





MANGROVE CRAB Aratus pisonii

hair tufts on claws, supratidal, on trees at water's edge
