Open House: We will host an Open House on Thu, Nov. 3 from 9-11am. Please encourage interested family & friends to visit! Volunteers are needed.


<u>Family Thanksgiving Feast</u>: RSVP forms for the Family Thanksgiving Feast must be turned in **by Nov. 1**.
