

# Kiley's Stone Skinz



Kiley's Stone Skinz are available in **sizes 6 to 16** and can be used to tie all of the stonefly's by changing the color of the dubbing.

**Stone Recipe using Stonefly Skinz size 6**

**Hook:** TMC200 Sizes 6 to 16

**Thread:** Mono

**Weight:** .025 Lead Wire

**Tails and Antenna:** MFC Legs (size small rubber legs/barred with marker)

**Rib:** UTC Brown Wire – Small

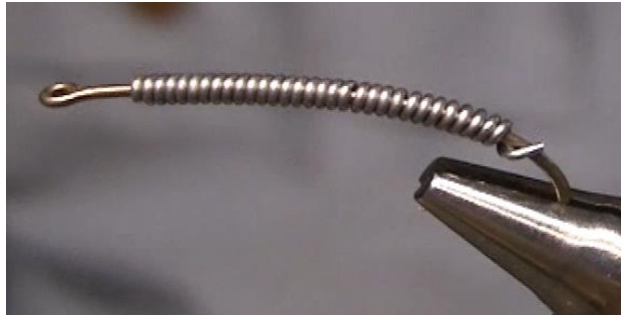
**Body and Thorax:** Ice Dub Tan

**Eyes:** Mono Eyes

**Collar:** UV Ice Dub Brown

**Marker:** Brown or Tan Sharpie

1. Start by adding the lead weight from the hook bend to the hook eye.



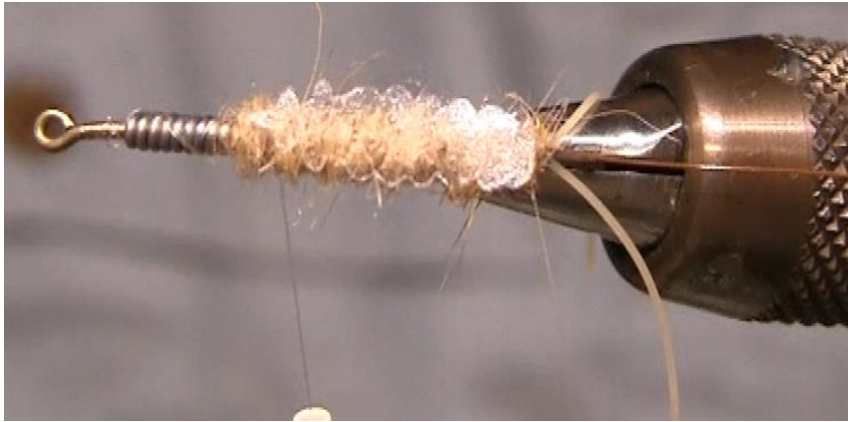
2. Use a jam knot to attach the thread to the hook just in front of the hook bend and Cover the lead wire with thread. Leave the thread at the bend of the hook.
3. Add the tail using the rubber legs.



4. Tie in the rib (UTC Wire) at the bend of the hook.
5. Add dubbing to the thread and create the body by dubbing over the lead weight. Dub to the 50% point of the hook shank.



6. Use a bodkin or a utility knife to remove the abdomen from the Stone Skinz sheet and apply it to the top of the dubbed body. Wrap the front of the Stone Skinz abdomen with thread to help hold it in place.



7. Using the notches in the Stone Skinz abdomen wrap the UTC wire forward and trim the wire.



8. Tie in the next set of legs at the front of the abdomen.



9. Add a small amount of dubbing and wrap back toward the legs. Then use a brush to stroke out some of the dubbing fibers.

10. Use a bodkin or a utility knife to remove a Stone Skinz wing casing from the sheet and apply it to the top of the dubbed body. Tie down using the thread at the front of the wing casing (side closest to the hook eye).



11. Color the wing case with a sharpie (color that matches the stone your tying).



12. Add dubbing for the next segment.



13. Tie in the next set of legs. After tying the legs in Pull the front to legs forward for the antenna. Wrap the thread back to the segment.



14. Brush out the dubbing and add the second wing casing and color it.



15. Add the mono eyes



16. Dub around the eyes. Then dub a collar using the UV Ice Dub Brown



17. Add the last wing casing. The tie in point will go just in front of the eyes. Color the wing casing.

18. Whip Finish

19. Brush out the Dubbing

20. Coat the Stone Skinz with Loon UV. Cure with the light.



21. Use a sharpie to create marking on the legs, tail, and antenna. Then trim to length.
