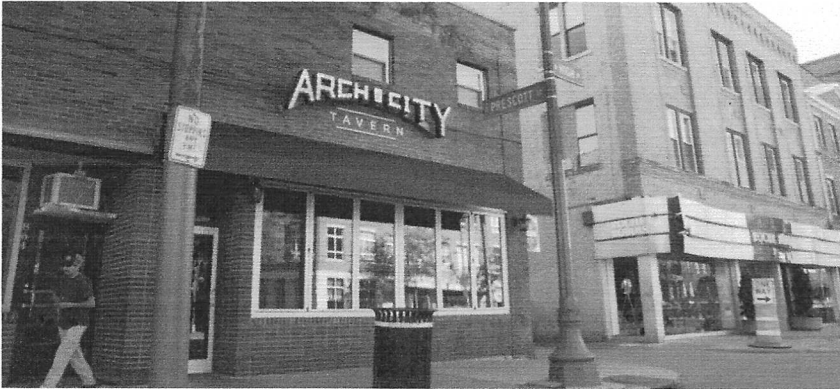

“With pride in our home town, we pay respect to the past while looking toward the future.”

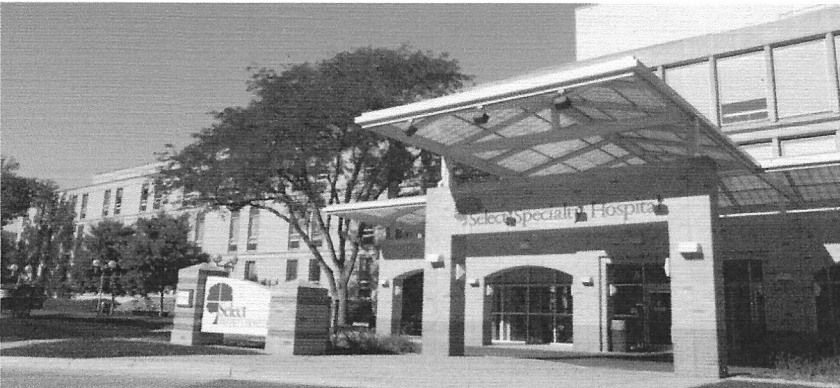

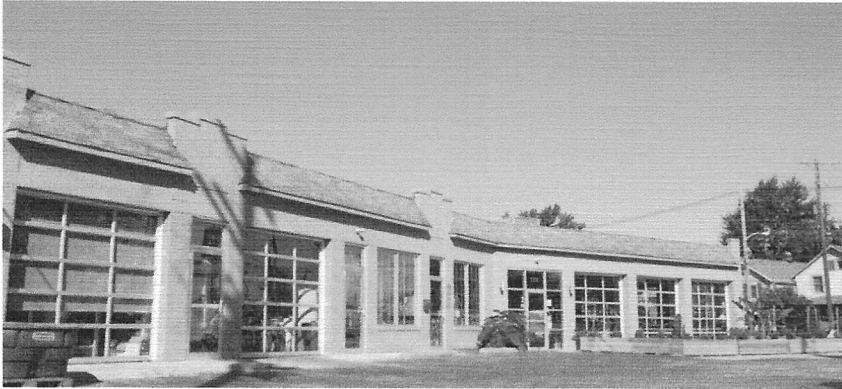

beautiful homes and neighborhoods, and while not anticipating a career in the business, now reflects, "I can see it was in my blood from the start."

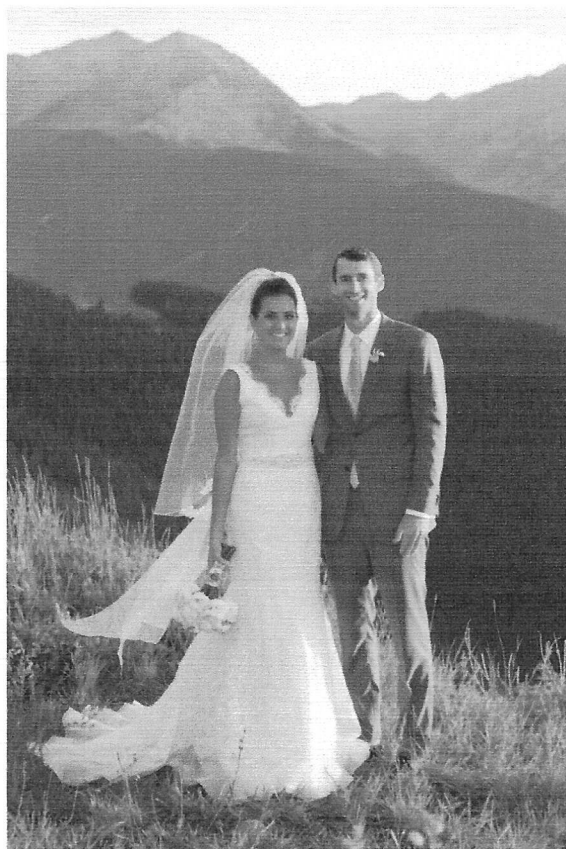
