To the Sherburn and Welcome City Councils,

The department logged 174 calls for service in the month of June. This brought the total for the year to 1,181. In comparison, the department logged 1094 calls in 2018 and 875 in 2017 for the same reporting period.

The department again conducted the bicycle rodeo this year. 15 children attended the event and \$500 in prizes were given out. The kids were taught safe operation of bicycles as well as having their bicycles examined and safety gear was discussed.

We will again be giving out certificates for free ice cream cones at Dairy Queen to anyone we see riding bicycles in a safe manner and wear a helmet and other protective gear. The department has done this for the last 4 years and the kids love this program. The certificates are provided to us by the Minnesota Chiefs of Police Association.

The department arranged for Responsible server training for all bartenders and clerks who serve or sell alcohol in their businesses. It was held at the Sherburn theater and was well attended.

We are currently looking for new part-time officers as we have lost some and are down to two on the roster. These officers work in a "fill in" role only but are important for the department when officers need time off
