

Third Grade Supply List

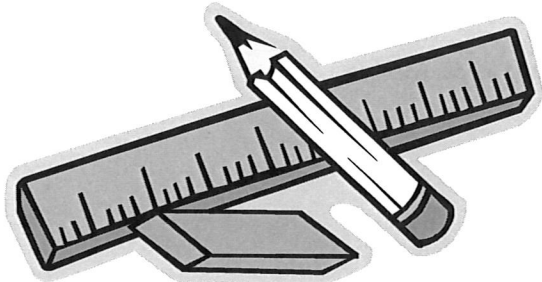
1. 2 three subject notebooks, Wide ruled
