Sewers: DeGoey reported that Karl Peters is working on the remaining sewer line. He set another manhole last week. He also reported that JP Drain is reviewing the video of the sewer lines to see if they can line a section that was not lined previously by SAK Construction.

Parks: Humke reported that the parks are being mowed. The Council also discussed what type of trees to plant in the park.

Tree Steward: Fouts will follow up on a request from 103 Walnut Dr to remove three trees.
