If you would like to set up automatic payment with Union Bank and do not have the form, please ask Strong Property Management to send you a form. You do NOT have to fill out the form if

you are going to mail your checks in. The form is ONLY for automatic payments. If you have signed up for automatic withdrawal you may want to contact Union Bank (1 800 836-5184) to confirm your automatic withdrawal was set up in time to make the March payment and if not you will need to write a check for the March payment. This is a good time to take a look at your safety devices, such as smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors. Replace batteries as needed. In April, we'll be asking you to update your emergency (census) forms. When we held our SCOPE presentation in November, we were reminded once again of the importance of this information. Our forms will now include a line for email address, as well as a few other "tweaks".

Sonoma Valley Fire & Rescue Authority is holding its annual SCOPE presentation and Hands Only CPR training. The SCOPE program includes emergency response, community preparedness, utility safety, and fire prevention. The Hands Only CPR training will teach you what to do until help arrives & also includes Automated External Defibrillator (AED) familiarization.
