

The Pump – turning it on and turning off

Our lake augmentation pump has been on since 4/20/2016 when the lake level was 15" below the target level. . It is to be turned on in the Spring when the water level is 8" below the normal high water mark.

5/25/2016 lake level is
4.5" below the target level
(target = 4" below high water
mark.)

During the Summer it is turned off when the water level reaches 4" below the normal high water mark.

<u>Dot DeYoung</u> - Prior to her 2003 move to Crooked Lake, Dot served as the Manager of the Utility Business Office at the City of Wyoming.
