MEETING MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER

The River City Cruisers Car Club meeting was held at the Hermann City Park on September 27, 2016 with 23 members present.

The meeting was called to order by President Doug Smith and Lynn Mead, treasurer, reported a balance of \$10,034.13.

The profits from the car show are as follows:

- * Food Stand—\$1587, down \$211 from 2015
- * Trophies— \$397, down \$31 from 2015
- * **50/50 raffle**—\$416, down \$200 from 2015
- * T-shirt sales—\$567, down \$20 from 2015
- * Quilt raffle—\$100, down \$27 from 2015
- * Registration—\$579, down \$273 from 2015
- * Saturday night cookout—spent \$252, spent \$576 less than 2015

We had a total profit of \$3393 which was about \$186 less than 2015. The difference from the fish fry to the BBQ made the biggest impact to cause our profit to come close to last year.

We had 202 cars registered for the show this year. Overall the car show was a success even with the last minute move to the high school.

There was several discussions on changing some things that either didn't work well this year or would help save money. There will be more discussion on these items and voting when more members are present at a meeting.

- We normally mail trophies to those that win and then leave early. Should we continue to do this or should they be present to win and then save the postage?
- Should we continue to give dash plaques to show & shine entries?
- Stop giving attendance prizes and roll that money into the goody bags? Drawing numbers didn't work well since many people leave throughout the show.

Josie said she was about 10 glasses short and then would have enough trophies for next year. Susie Horstman made a motion for Josie to buy 10 glasses now and Bernadine Oetterer seconded it.

We received thank you notes for the club's memorial donation to Jip Rector and Becky Hagedorn's dad. The Crusade Against Cancer is thinking of moving to the 2nd Friday (June 9) and moving to the Riverfront.

The next cruise night is October 14 at Hardees. We will also be starting the breakfast cruise again on the 2nd Sunday of the month.
