



Preparation for Rodent Control and Treatment

On the above date a technician from EAKO Pest Control (508.588.5897) will be treating for rodents. Prior to the treatment the following preparations are necessary to achieve proper control. The following methods will be used to minimize pesticide hazards. If you have any health concerns that restricts the use of any rodenticides or controls listed below, please contact management and show this notice to your physician.

How to Prepare for the Service:

Please have all lower kitchen and bathroom cabinets cleared of ANY items in order for the technician to be able to inspect for access points and exclusion areas. Cover any and all exposed food and utensils. Do not leave any food or utensils on kitchen counters. Please clear stove of any items (pots, pans, utensils, etc.) and to NOT have the stove in use while treatment/inspection is being performed (the technician will need to pull stove away from wall to inspect). Since the technician will be inspecting the entire unit for exclusion areas in which he/she will need access to walls, corners of each room, baseboard heat areas (if applicable), and closet floors should be cleared of any items. If you are experiencing rodent activity in certain areas, please leave a detailed note on kitchen counter detailing the activity.

Depending on the level of activity, treatment may include the placement of glue monitors/traps, rodent bait, bait stations and may include dust treatments into wall voids.

The Materials Applied: (will include one or more of the following):

- First Strike (bromadiolone, EPA reg # 7173-258)
- Contrac Meal Place Pack (bromadiolone, EPA reg # 12455-75)
- Rozol Tracking Powder (clothianidin, metofluthrin, piperonyl butoxide, EPA reg # 1021-1767)
- MB 72 Glue Boards (non-toxic, EPA exempt ***CONTAINS PEANUT IN GLUE***)
- Provoke Bait (non-toxic, EPA exempt)
- Snap Traps (non-toxic, EPA exempt)
- Pur Black foam (carbon, polyurethane, EPA exempt)

If you have a health condition that is especially sensitive to certain pest control procedures, please contact your physician and review this notice with your doctor.
